INSPIRATION

The inspiration for this collection is a mythological creature named Fenrir . Fenrir or Fenrisúlfr, also referred to as Hróðvitnir and Vánagandr is a wolf in Norse mythology. Fenrir, together with Hel and the World Serpent, is a child of Loki and giantess Angrboða.

Fenrir has been depicted as an evil creature who is dangerous to humanity. However in reality he was just strong and he was converted into an evil creature out of people's fear. So I wanted to honour him through this collection.

Fenrir, also called **Fenrisúlfr**, monstrous wolf of Norway Mythology . He was the son of the demoniac god Loki and a giantess. Fearing Fenrir's strength and knowing that only evil could be expected of him, the gods bound him with a magical chain made of the sound of a cat's footsteps, the beard of a woman, the breath of fish, and other occult elements. When the chain was placed upon him, Fenrir bit off the hand of the god Tyr. He was gagged with a sword and was destined to lie bound to a rock until the Ragnarok (Doomsday), when he will break his bonds and fall upon the gods.

INTERESTING FACTS ABOUT FENRIR

- Fenrir means 'he who dwells in marshes 'in old Norse language.
- Despite being tied with the thin chain he was destined to break free and kill the god Odin during the events of Ragnarok but will in turn be killed by Odin's son vidarr.
- The unbreakable chain which was used to tie up Fenrir was made by dwarfs using ingredients such as sound of a cats step, the beard of a woman, the roots of a mountain, bear's sensibility, fish's breath and bird's spittle.
- Fenrir had a sword in his mouth because of which he couldn't close his mouth and his saliva created the river Van meaning hope in Nordic language. Hope as in he will break free to revenge and kill Odin.
- Only Fenrir was allowed in Valhalla among his siblings.
